- High quality teacher training from National Literacy Trust
- A pack of shelves and soft furnishings to create libraries and reading spaces
- Resources and information about children's books, publishers and other national initiatives and literacy charities
- Opportunities to meet and host publishers, authors and illustrators
- Access to events to build ongoing relationships with each school's local library, local bookseller and schools library service
- Membership of the Libraries for Primaries Network and ongoing support from National Literacy Trust around encouraging reading for pleasure both within, and beyond, the school gates.

- Delivery of books from publishers to fulfilment facilities **Spring 2027** with window agreed in consultation with fulfilment partner for packing and onward delivery **Jan – April 2027**
- Delivery to schools between **January and April 2027** (detail to be agreed with successful applicant).

### Lot 2. Furniture Year 1:

- Delivery to schools between **January and April 2027** (detail to be agreed with successful applicant).

### Lot 3. Audiobooks Year 1:

- Deliver/provide access to schools annually in Spring, in line with book deliveries (to be agreed with successful applicant)

This tender will cover three academic years, **2026 – 2029**.

Timeframes for subsequent year deliveries are expected to be along similar lines to those outlined for 2026-2027.

The details for the following year, including and timings will be confirmed in consultation with the successful applicant in an end of year review **Summer 2027**.

Organisations interested in submitting a tender for the opportunity to provide the fulfilment aspects of this project should provide costings for the following on the accompanying online form.

- Co-ordination and receipt of deliveries from over 30 suppliers and providing storage and insurance for damage and loss for all books
- Management of stock shortages, damages and picking errors including communication with publishers and NLT around replacements
- Picking sets of 500 individual titles and packing collection into branded boxes along with supporting resources/materials incl. provision of packing boxes and other required packaging
- Oversight of delivery of book collections to UK school addresses, inside the building (No curb side only deliveries) with adherence to agreed schedule. Deliveries are carried out in a wave annually Jan-April.
- Provision of proof of delivery and management of solution to delivery issues and damages in a prompt manner within 28 days.

Organisations interested in submitting a tender for the opportunity to provide the furniture aspects of this project should provide costings for the following on the accompanying form.

- Manufacture of 1675 furniture packs across 3 years, with a value of (£950 incl. VAT per pack), to include multiple shelves and an element of soft seating. (525 packs in Y1, 575 each in Y2 and Y3)
- Packing and safe delivery (inside building – no curb side deliveries can be accepted) of furniture packs to 525 locations across England in Year one, and 575 per year in years 2 and 3. Deliveries to be carried out in adherence to agreed schedule, and are carried out in a wave annually Jan-April.
- Provision of proof of delivery
- Follow up support/problem solving required to ensure deliveries meet all intended locations, with prompt resolution of issues within 28 days.
- Direct contacts with schools in cases of damages, provision of warranties etc

In addition to the quotation, please provide further supporting information on:

- Insurance of materials for damage and loss whilst on site and in transit from storage to schools.
- Details of any manufacturer guarantee/quality mark for furniture packages

Organisations interested in submitting a tender for the opportunity to provide the audio aspects of this project should provide costings for the following on the accompanying form.:

- Provide audiobook provision of adequate scale to 1675 settings across 3 years, with a value of (£150 incl. VAT per set), including playing devices as required for physical media.
- Physical Media: Packing and safe delivery (inside building – no curb side deliveries can be accepted) to 1675 England locations. Deliveries are carried out in a wave annually Jan-April.
- Digital Solutions: Provide and maintain ongoing access from Spring in each annual wave.
- Provision of proof of delivery as required.
- Follow up support/problem solving required to ensure deliveries meet all intended locations, with prompt issue resolution within maximum of 28 days.
- Direct contacts with schools in cases of damages, provision of warranties or difficulties accessing or using the provision.

In addition to the quotation, please provide further supporting information on:

- Insurance of materials whilst on site and in transit as necessary
- Details of contents of range of books accessible and for digital content, details of any access restrictions over time.
