About the National Literacy Trust

The National Literacy Trust is an independent charity that empowers children, young people and adults with the literacy skills they need to succeed.

Literacy changes everything. It gives you the tools to get the most out of life, and the power to shape your future. It opens the door to the life you want. Over the last 30 years, we have continued to support schools, families and communities on a local and national level.

Our evidence-based Young Writers programme supports schools to develop lasting writing-for-enjoyment practices with the view that every young person is a writer.

Our projects use a three-pillar model that emphasises the importance of memorable experiences, working with professional authors and providing a real audience and purpose for writing. Every school participating in Young Writers is provided with support to use each pillar to help improve students' engagement with writing.

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Introduction

In 2025, we found that writing enjoyment amongst children and young people aged 8 to 18 was at the lowest level we've recorded. Our research highlights that exploring stories through lyrics can be an effective way to re-engage young people with reading for enjoyment and writing for pleasure. Just over 3 in 5 (60.7%) children and young people age 8-18 regularly read song lyrics digitally; and writing song lyrics is also popular among children and young people age 8-18, with almost 1 in 5 (17.8%) reporting that they write lyrics on a screen at least once a month.

This gave us a clear mandate to celebrate National Storytelling Week 2026, to promote writing enjoyment through the art of storytelling. Like song lyrics, stories teach us about the world, they allow us to step into someone else's shoes and feel empathy, they help us to relax and escape and they can help develop essential literacy skills. Storytelling has never been more important.

In 2026, National Storytelling Week took place from 2 February to 8 February. Created by the Society for Storytelling, this fantastic annual event is a joyful celebration of the power of sharing stories. The National Literacy Trust, supported by Amazon, celebrated with the theme of **Soundtrack your Story**. Everyone has their own musical story - whether it's in the songs we love and the music we dance to, through British Sign Language and the rhythms we feel, the soundscapes of everyday life or the soundtracks we hear in films and games. Music connects us

to words. It helps us express who we are and how we see the world. Key Stage 2/ P4-P7 pupils explored storytelling through rap with Alim Kamara, by responding to writing prompts through interactive workshops and activities in school. This anthology is a celebration of the writing and music that was produced.
